 Debian packages
 closer to the users (department, lab)

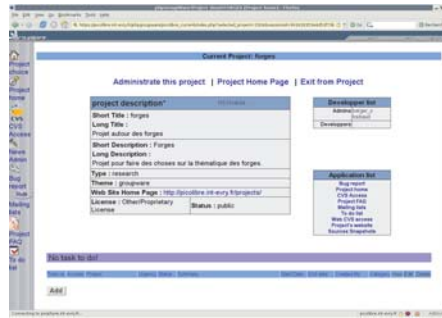
Developped at GET

 introduction to collaboration, software development

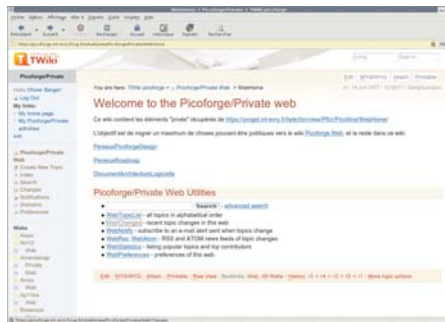
All free/opensource software

Integration approach (vs. rebuild)

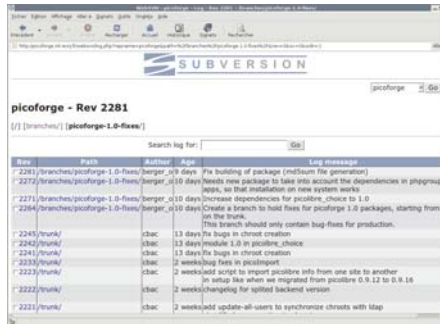
Integration with CAS & Shibboleth (soon)

 static site and restricted wikis

 RSS feeds, subscriptions

Autonomous project administration
 addition of new members, new wikis, new lists...
